**PRO LIFE NEWS:** Following on from the 40 Days for Life event this year there are a number of other forthcoming Pro – Life events taking place in the next few weeks; *Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2018*; *Act of Silent Witness* – Gregory Boulevard This year's SPUC Silent Witness event will be on the day after the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the implementation of the Abortion Act in 1967, a piece of legislation which has led to the deaths of millions of innocent unborn children.
