SIX BLESSEDS TO BE CANONIZED ON SUNDAY 14th OCTOBER 2018: Six Blesseds will be canonized this Sunday, during an Ordinary Public Consistory for the Canonization of the Blesseds: *Pope Paul VI* (Giovanni Battista Montini), Supreme Pontiff; *Oscar Arnulfo Romero Galdámez*, Archbishop of San Salvador, martyr; *Francesco Spinelli*, diocesan priest, founder of the Institute of the Sisters Adorers of the Most Holy Sacrament; *Vincenzo Romano*, diocesan priest; *Maria Katharina Kasper*, virgin, founder of the Institute of the Poor Handmaids of Jesus Christ; *Nazaria Ignacia de Santa Teresa de Jesús* (née: Nazaria Ignacia March Mesa), founder of the Congregation of the Missionary Crusaders of the Church. Bishop Patrick has asked that a special bidding prayer be inserted in the Prayers of the Faithful this Sunday in all parishes of the Diocese, to give thanks to God and pray for their gracious intercession.
