Fr McLaughlin's took place in his home Parish Church of Saint Mary Lagg, Malin, Co Donegal, Ireland, this week. Although Fr McLaughlin retired from active ministry in 2000 he served in the Diocese for 42 years and celebrated his Diamond Jubilee of Ordination last year. Margaret died on *11<sup>th</sup> April 2019* aged 100 years old and her Funeral Mass took place in April in Berkshire.
