REQUIESCAT IN PACE: Please remember in your prayers to pray for the repose of the soul of *Monsignor Louis McRaye* who died on *Sunday 7th July 2019* aged *104 years old*. Mgr. McRaye was born in 1915 and was an accomplished academic in the fields of English and Law and he was ordained a priest in 1962. The contribution of his 57 years of priestly ministry will be remembered most as Catholic Chaplain to the University of Warwick (1966 – 83) and Spiritual Director at St Mary’s College, Oscott (1983 – 94). As the Church prepares for the Canonisation of Cardinal John Henry Newman, Mgr. McRaye was a dedicated friend and supporter of the work of the Newman Association, generously giving of his time to educate the laity. May he rest in peace after his long life in the Lord’s service.
